Week 1	Love and Relationships	Research one of the following romantic poets and how they convey love in their poetry: Percy Bysshe Shelley Lord Byron
Week 2	Love and Relationships	Explore how Byron presents love and loss in the poem 'When We Two Parted.'
Week 3	Love and Relationships	Analyse how Shelley presents love through natural imagery in the poem 'Love's Philosophy.'
Week 4	Love and Relationships	Explore the theme of possessive love in the poem 'Porphyria's Lover.'
Week 5	Love and Relationships	Create a revision poster for your half term assessment exploring the aspects of language, structure and form that are needed when analysing poetry.
Week 6	Love and Relationships	Research the structure of a sonnet and explore why Barrett-Browning uses the sonnet form to express her love in the poem 'Sonnet 29'.

Week 7	Love and Relationships	Imagine you are the Farmer's Bride; write a diary entry explaining your thoughts and feelings about the marriage.
Week 8	Love and Relationships	How does Day-Lewis present the parental relationship in 'Walking Away.'?
Week 9	Love and Relationships	Compare how the parental relationship presented in 'Before You Were Mine' differs or relates to that of the poem 'Walking Away.'
Week 10	Love and Relationships	Create a detailed plan for your end of unit exam response. Focus on the structure, form and language of the poems you have studied.
Week 11	Love and Relationships	Create the opening to a story that is inspired by one of the poems you have studied so far, this term.
Week 12	Love and Relationships	Using the poem 'Winter Swans' write a description of the scene created by the poet using a range of similes, metaphors, personification, sensory description and ambitious vocabulary.
