

School Skirt Guidelines

At Weatherhead High School we have high expectations and standards in relation to school uniform for all of our students. School uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the overall ethos of Weatherhead High School.

Aims:

- To instil pride and identity
- To support positive behaviour and discipline
- To protect children from social pressures to dress in a particular way
- School uniform supports effective teaching and learning

Students are not permitted to wear a PE/Gymslip style skirt or a straight/pencil style skirt. All students must wear a navy skirt of an appropriate length i.e. knee length.
