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w/c 4 th Jun	Feed forward on End of Year Test.	Potential homework includes: Re-read fed forward test to ensure a secure understanding.
w/c 11 th Jun	How do jobs affect development?	Looking at the four types of jobs (primary, secondary, tertiary and quaternary) and how certain countries have more types than others. Potential homework includes: Asking 10 family/friends what type of job they have and then categorising it into one of the four job types. Research two contrasting countries and how their jobs differ.
w/c 18 th Jun	How does trade affect development?	'Trade game' – group activity. Potential homework includes: Create a poster about Fairtrade; Research 10 facts about the EU; Write up analysis from Trade Game task undertaken in class etc.
w/c 25 th Jun	Aid	Looking at the different types of aid (bilateral, multilateral, charitable, and emergency). Potential homework includes: Complete homework sheet on the 'Consequences of poverty and aid'; learning the definitions of the 4 types of aid for a quiz next lesson; research a successful aid project in an LDC (e.g. 'Play pumps').
w/c 2 nd Jul	Case study developing country	Computer task – complete a country fact file for an MDC e.g. Japan in pairs; focussing on trade, job types, development indicators, aid. OR 'bingo' around the room activity to complete fact file. Potential homework includes: Final purple pen of this year's work.
w/c 9 th Jul	Case study developed country	Computer task – complete a country fact file for an LDC e.g. Kenya in pairs; focussing on trade, job types, development indicators, aid.
