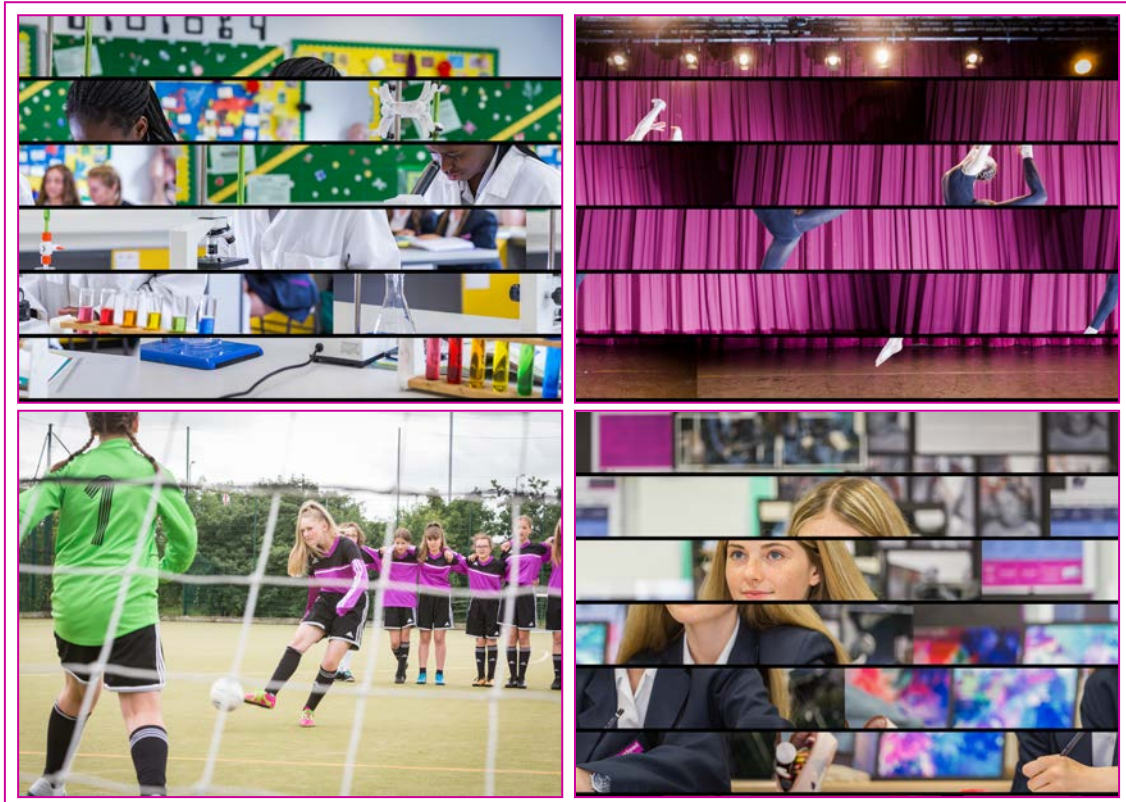

## How will my child's progress be assessed?

- Teachers' regular marking of your child's books. Comments and targets set by teachers will guide your child to make progress in their learning.
- Throughout the year, your child will complete tests and assessments to consolidate subject knowledge and to prepare your child for their final GCSE/BTEC grade.
- Mock examinations take place during the Autumn & Spring term.

## When will my child's progress be assessed?

### Autumn Term:

- You will receive a Progress Update that will inform you of the progress your child is making in all their subjects.

### Spring Term:

- During this term, you will receive a formal report, which will inform you of the progress your child is making in their GCSE/BTEC subjects.
- You will receive a copy of your child's mock examination results.
- Parents' Evening takes place in during this term and it is an opportunity for you and your child to meet with your child's subject teachers to discuss progress being made towards their GCSE examinations.

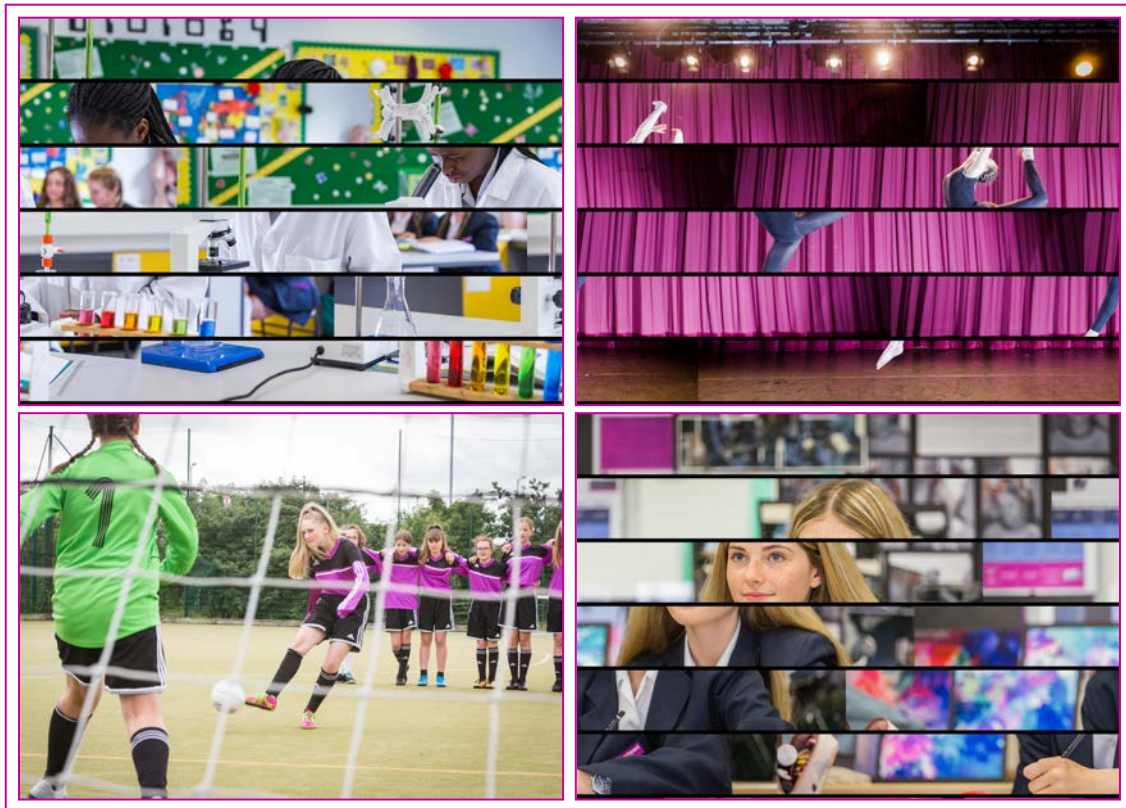
