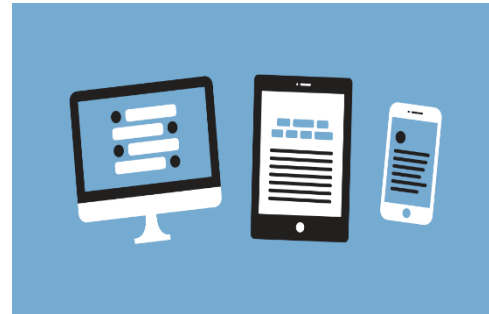

April – September 2020, the story so far...



Careers resources were delivered through Google Classroom to Year 11,12 and 13, in order to allow students to access them from home. Many companies began to offer digital work experience and online publications free of charge in order so that students could still engage in independent career learning during the lockdown. Deloitte ran a digital work experience programme called ASPIRE, which one of our Year 12 students successfully applied for and completed in the summer.



This year has been challenging for us all, and our students have faced unprecedented change. They had to show resilience as they adapted to home learning. The pandemic has really highlighted just how important school community is for the wellbeing of all of us. Students have missed out on key careers education and guidance since March, but many have engaged in online research and have accessed careers through the Google Classrooms.
